How to get to Camp Pringle

From Nanaimo:

South on Hwy. 1, through Ladysmith, Chemainus and Duncan. Turn right off Hwy. at Cobble Hill Road. Follow signs for Shawnigan Lake. Watch for Camp Pringle and Provincial Park signs and turn left on to West Shawnigan Lake Rd. If you get to the Provincial Park, backtrack one driveway to the Camp Pringle driveway.

From Victoria:

North on Hwy. 1. Turn left at Shawnigan Lake Road, part way up the Malahat. The road goes along the Lake. Watch for the Provincial Park on the right. Camp Pringle driveway is the next one past the Park.
