Mission Statement

Vancouver Island Unitarian Committee

To promote Unitarian Universalism on Vancouver Island and surrounding areas, and foster personal connection among the members of the participating fellowships.

Mandate VIUC:

Each member congregation must vote to authorize the formation of the VIUC, Vancouver Island Unitarian Committee on an annual basis. The authorization acknowledges the responsibility for the actions of the VIUC, including assuring appropriate insurance has been arranged and verified. Any shortfall would be based on a per person allocation, although none is expected it would need to be noted on each congregations budget. The VIUC is instructed to host as a subcommittee of member congregations events that satisfy our Mission. All events are intended to cover the costs associated. The VIUC will have an AGM within the calendar year and produce a financial statement for the member congregations. Voting members of the Committee are designated by the member congregations, those with more than 100 members have three voting members and congregations with less than 100 have 2 voting members. No proxy votes but substitution is permitted. Election of Committee Chair for an initial term of two years and subsequent terms for the position of chair shall be three years, Secretary/Treasurer for a three year term, a nominating committee of three for a three year term, a Publicist for an initial term of one year and subsequent terms of three years, will be held at the AGM scrutinized by the chair of the nominating committee. No less than two signing officers will be appointed by the executive.
